RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR FFY 2020 PENNSYLVANIA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ENTITLEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED) administers the Small Cities Program authorized by Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended (42 U.S.D. 5301 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Small Cities Program provides financial assistance to eligible communities in the State to undertake various community and economic development activities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Program Act of October 11, 1984 (P.L. 906, No. 179), the Small Cities Program is designated the Pennsylvania Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Program, hereinafter referred to as the "Program"; and

WHEREAS, Susquehanna County receives an annual allocation pursuant to said Program; and

WHEREAS, the Susquehanna County Redevelopment Authority prepared an Application on behalf of the County to use the County's FFY 2020 Entitlement Program allocation of \$261,920 for Sidewalks In Hop Bottom and Lanesboro Boroughs, Water & Sewer Improvements in Oakland Borough, and Street Improvements in the Borough of Susquehanna Depot;

WHEREAS, the County wishes to file said Applications with DCED;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Susquehanna, that approval is hereby given to file with DCED, the FFY 2020 Program Applications, including all certifications, understandings and assurances contained therein, and that the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Application on behalf of the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if CDBG funds are determined by the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development to be expended on ineligible program costs or do not meet a national objective, the County of Susquehanna Board of Commissioners agrees to repay the proportion deemed ineligible from non-federal sources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Susquehanna does hereby authorize, through a Management Agreement, the administration of the program through the Susquehanna County Housing and Redevelopment Authority.
