ORDINANCE NO: 2023-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PORTIONS OF CHAPTER 107 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONTROSE WITH RESPECT TO PARKING ON LAKE AVENUE.

The Council of the Borough of Montrose, Susquehanna County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

**Section 1.  
Authority**

Pursuant to 8 Pa. C.S.A. §1202(31) the Borough of Montrose is authorized to regulate parking and provide parking accommodations to promote the convenience and protection of the public.

**Section 2.  
Prohibiting Parking at All Times on Portions of Lake Avenue**

The Code of the Borough of Montrose §107.22 is hereby amended by adding Lake Avenue to the list of streets upon which parking a vehicle at any time is prohibited as described below:

<u>Name of Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Lake Avenue	East	From Maple Street toward the direction of Prospect Street a distance of 155 feet

**Section 3.  
Severability**

That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Council of the Borough of Montrose hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

**Section 4.  
Repealer**


That all other ordinances or parts of laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


**Section 5.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.


