

ORDINANCE NUMBER 21

PROHIBITION OF ACCUMULATION AND DUMPING
OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OR DUMPING OR BURYING OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE IN THE BOROUGH OF LITTLE MEADOWS AND THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC OR PRIVATE DUMPS WITHIN THE LIMITES OF THE SAID BOROUGH, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

The Little Meadows Borough Council, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania hereby ordain as follows:

No person, association, firm or corporation shall keep or suffer to remain upon his or her premises, or on any private property, any garbage, offal, carcass, putrid matter or other offensive or unwholesome matter, or cast the same upon any lot or piece of ground within the Borough of Little Meadows as a public or private dump or burial ground or garbage, refuse or rubbish. Any person, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than three hundred (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days. Provided: Each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.
